<u>In Junior Short Dance, should the Silver Samba Sequence started on the Judges' left side be called 1SS?</u>	<u>No. As stipulated in Communication 1857, 1SS is the Sequence with the first (number one) Step on the Judges' side of the rink, i.e. on the right corner of the Judges' side. The Sequence with the first (number one) Step on the far left corner of the Judges' opposite side of the rink is called 2SS.</u>
