RE: Non-U.S. Citizen Eligibility to Compete

Thank you for your interest in competing at a U.S. Figure Skating qualifying competition during the 2018 competition season. Non-U.S. Citizens who are members in good standing with U.S. Figure Skating and have never competed internationally for another skating federation are **NOT** required to complete an application to compete.

All Non-U.S. Citizens who have represented a foreign federation at any level of skating competition must make an application to the chair of the Competitions Committee by submitting a Non-U.S. Citizen Application to Compete (form CC-01) in English. This form is available online at www.usfigureskating.org (competition forms section). The applicant must meet the test level qualifications* and also comply with rules 2242-2247 in the U.S. Figure Skating Rulebook. You are strongly encouraged to read and understand these rules as full compliance is your responsibility.

I urge you to begin the application process as soon as possible. You **MAY NOT** register for the 2018 qualifying competition season prior to completing this process. An application shall not be considered complete until the chair of the Competitions Committee has received all required or subsequently requested documentation. If the application is approved, the Chair of the U.S. Figure Skating Competitions Committee will send the applicant a letter of permission. Please note that email is the preferred method for all communication and submission.

Online registration is the only method for entry into the U.S. Figure Skating Qualifying Season. Please see below for the registration timeline's pursuant to rule 2401.
