

**Technical Official Activity Requirements to Maintain Active Status  
(September 2015)**

<b>Requirements</b>	<b>All Disciplines and Levels</b>
<b>Education</b>	<p>Rules Review Course and Assessment in discipline; completed by deadline as determined by TPC each year.</p> <p>Viewing the current Technical Panel Webinar</p>
<b>Activity</b>	<p>Service as technical official at a minimum of one competition in the last 15 months, including four event segments; exceptions may be made to the segment requirement for dance, pairs and synchronized officials, where there are fewer opportunities for activity.</p> <p>For officials holding appointments in more than one discipline:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Service in one area of certification within S/P/D will also qualify for another within S/P/D (e.g. TS for DO, Singles TS for Pairs TS, TC for TS.)</li> <li>• Service as S/P/D DO will also qualify for SyS DO, and vice-versa.</li> <li>• Service as S/P/D TS or TC does NOT qualify for SyS TS or TC.</li> <li>• Video Operator activity does NOT count as TS, TC or DO activity in any discipline.</li> </ul> <p>Attendance at up to one technical panel seminar or school may count as official activity and may be taken into consideration both when assessing an official's activity and determining active/inactive status. Those attending a seminar or school will receive a certificate of activity following the seminar or school to acknowledge commensurate activity.</p>
